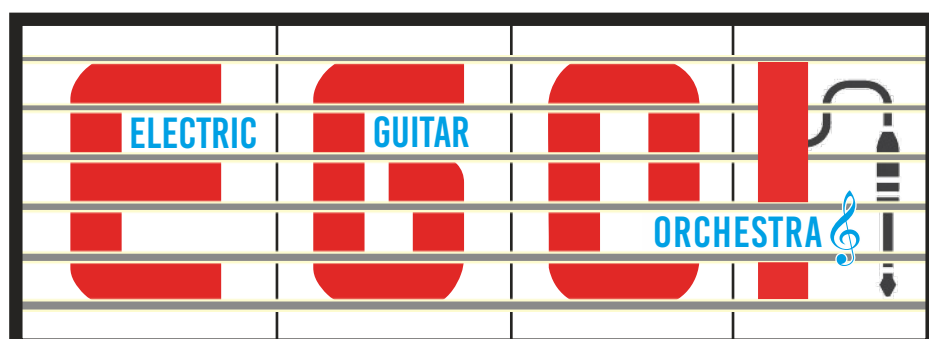

BOGCHERINI Minuet
